Assigning Permission Sets

Overview

In order for the users in an organization to use Cloud Coach Fundamentals, they must have a permission set assigned. There are two ways to add users to Cloud Coach Fundamentals; (1) from an individual user's profile, or (2) bulk assign them from the permission set itself. Assigning permission set(s) to a user allows them to create projects and templates, manage tasks with My Assignments, monitor the Gantt views, or have admin privileges.

- 1. Cloud Coach Fundamentals Permission sets:
 - a. *CCMI* | *Admin Permissions* allows users to go to getting started and access sample data
 - b. CCMI | Minimum User Permissions allows users to create projects and templates, manage tasks with My Assignments, and monitor the Gantt views
- 2. To assign permission sets by the individual user, go to Setup \rightarrow Users \rightarrow Select an Individual to edit
 - a. Scroll down to Permission Set Assignments and click Edit Assignments
 - b. Select the permission set(s) from the Available Permission Sets for the user, click Add so they display in the Enabled Permission Sets.
 - c. Click Save
- To assign permission sets in bulk, go to Setup → Permission Sets → Select CCMI | Admin Permissions or CCMI | Minimum User Permissions
 - a. Scroll down to System Permissions and click to edit
 - b. Click Manage Assignments \rightarrow Add Assignments \rightarrow Select Users
 - c. Click Assign

Additional Configuration for Field Sets

Overview:

Cloud Coach makes use of Field Sets, allowing each org to customize what data is shown and where. Field Sets allow for different combinations of Fields to be displayed and can be both Managed and Custom Fields on the Managed Objects. They're easy to edit and do not require custom coding knowledge to use, making them a great solution to allow admins to make a change on the fly to improve views for Users. *Though the Field Sets for External Project View, Time Entry, and Timecard are listed on Fundamentals objects, access is limited to customers who have purchased the Professional upgrade from Fundamentals.*

- 1. Field Sets on the Project Object (CCMI_Milestone_Project__c):
 - a. Column Headers (CCMI_column_headers)
 - i. Controls the Column Headers for the Project List View on the Cross Project Gantt
 - b. Gantt (CCMI_gantt)
 - i. Deprecated; Field set no longer applicable
 - c. New Project (CCMI_new_task)
 - i. Controls Fields in the Project Creation Wizard for new Projects and Templates
 - d. Side Panel (CCMI_sidepanel)
 - i. Controls the Fields in the Side Panel for the Project on the Cross Project Gantt View
- 2. Field Sets on the Project Task Object (CCMI__Milestone_Task__c):
 - a. Column Headers (CCMI__column_headers)
 - i. Controls the Column Header Fields for the list view on the My Assignments page
 - b. New Task (CCMI__new_task)
 - i. Controls the Fields in the modal when creating a new Task
 - c. Side Panel (CCMI___sidepanel)

- i. Controls the Fields displayed in the side panel of a Task
- d. Timelines List (CCMI__timelines_list)
 - i. Controls the Column Headers for the list view on Project Timelines List View
